

<u>Colorado Works Change Coming:</u> <u>Serving Individuals With Drug-Related Felonies</u>

Who: Individuals Eligible for Colorado Works

What: Colorado Works Is Now Serving Individuals With Drug-Related Felonies

Starting in June 2023, a person convicted of a drug-related felony is now eligible for assistance without restrictions (e.g., treatment plan, verification, etc.) under the Colorado Works (CW) program.

Why: House Bill 22-1259

<u>House Bill 2022-1259</u> (HB 22-1259), also known as the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) bill, made several changes to the Colorado Works program, including removing barriers to serving individuals with drug-related felonies.

When: These changes will go into effect June 1, 2023.
