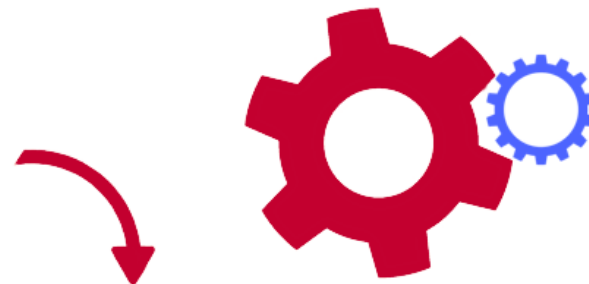


# AND-SO MED RE-EXAM DATE

The Adult Financial (AF) re-exam date for a Med-9 form will be completed by CBMS based on your data entry!

The AF re-exam date will not set if AF is closed when you complete the Medical Conditions screen.



To set a re-exam date, you must rescind first.

The AF program is therefore pending or open, and CBMS functionality can set the re-exam date when the Medical Conditions screen is completed.



Intake: re-exam set from the application date and the Length of Disability, the 1st month will include the month of application.

RRR: re-exam date set from the 1st month of the new certification period and the Length of Disability.

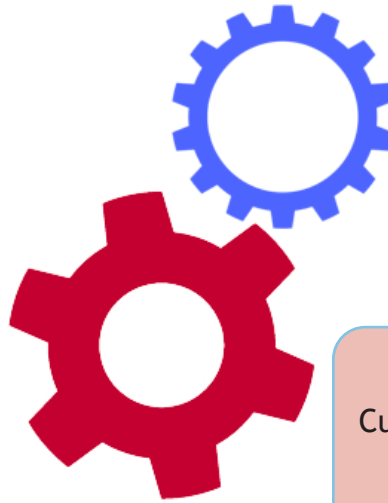
Ongoing: re-exam date sets with the first month as the month of the exam date with the length based on the Length of Disability.



# AND-SO MED RE-EXAM DATE

If Qualifying Disability is entered, the “Disability Indicator” should always be set to **Disabled - 12 months or more**

If Social Factors are entered, the “Disability Indicator” should always be set to **Disabled - less than 12 months.**



**IF**  
Customer has an ARG (Disability Determination) at RRR.  
**AND**  
Diary Date is more than 6 months from 1st month of certification.  
**AND**  
Med-9 is not needed.



**THEN:**  
Add new row on Medical Conditions screen and complete all additional fields.  
ARG information on the Disability Determination screen.  
ARG can be used as name of physician and practice.
