


# CASH DISCREPANCY/CLAIMS FLOWCHART

## Adult Financial and Colorado Works

This document outlines the process for establishing (or invalidating) a claim for Cash Programs both as a flow chart and a process outline. # CASH DISCREPANCY/CLAIMS TEXT

## Adult Financial and Colorado Works

1. CBMS User begins to process a case.
2. Run EDBC.
3. Has the benefit amount changed more than \$200? If **No**, no discrepancy created. Stop here. If **Yes**, then go to the next step.
4. Discrepancy created.
5. CBMS User goes to **Wrap Up** to authorize the case.
6. Pop-up message received on Claim Summary page.
7. Did the CBMS user select row for AF or CW discrepancy? If **No**, Unestablish Claim button is not enabled. Stop here. If **Yes**, then go to the next step.
8. If the user did **NOT** select the Unestablish Claim button, research status of the discrepancy is changed to “Researched-Valid”, and a claim is initiated. Case Is Authorized.
9. If the user **DID** select the Unestablish Claim button, research status of the discrepancy is changed to “Researched-Invalid”. Case Is Authorized.
