Eligibility, Coverage, and Services Overview

Family Planning Limited Benefit (FAMPL)

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Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Meets all Health First Colorado eligibility requirements <u>with the exception of income.</u>The income limit for this program has been expanded up to 260% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).No gender or age restriction.Renewal occurs every 12 months.
Coverage	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Covers family planning, family planning-related, and reproductive health services.Family Planning is a <u>limited</u> benefit. It is not full Health First Colorado coverage. 
Services Overview	<p>FAMPL benefits <u>include but are not limited to:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Birth controlFamily planning and reproductive health screeningsDiagnosisTreatmentOffice visits <p>Prenatal, Labor, Delivery, and Postpartum care <u>are not covered.</u></p>




Limited Emergency Medicaid Services and Reproductive Health Care Services (EMS/RHCS)

EMS/RHCS	
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meets all Health First Colorado eligibility requirements <u>with the exception of citizenship or qualified immigration requirements.</u> No gender or age restriction. A member can request EMS/RHCS at any time, even if they have not experienced an emergency. Renewal occurs every 12 months.
Coverage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> EMS covers services a medical provider considers necessary to treat an emergency medical condition. RHCS covers family planning, family planning-related and reproductive health services. EMS/RHCS is a <u>combined, limited</u> benefit. It is <u>not</u> full Health First Colorado coverage. 
Services Overview	<p>EMS benefits include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Health emergencies Labor and delivery Dialysis for end-state renal disease <p>RHCS benefits include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Birth control Family planning and reproductive health screenings Diagnosis Treatment Office visits <p>Follow up care after an emergency, Prenatal and Postpartum care are <u>not</u> covered.</p>



Cover All Coloradans (CAC)

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Eligibility	<p>Meets all Health First Colorado eligibility requirements for program requested <u>with the exception of citizenship or qualified immigration requirements</u> AND meets <u>one or more</u> of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Actively Pregnant • 18 years of age or younger • Active in 1-year postpartum period and must have been MAGI pregnant eligible during pregnancy • Only Magi Pregnant/CHP Prenatal are gender restricted. • Age restriction: If a person is not pregnant or postpartum, coverage ends when they turn 19. • Non-Magi eligibility differs in eligibility from Magi/CHP+. • Renewal occurs every 12 months or at the end of the 12 month guaranteed postpartum period.
Coverage	<p>CAC is <u>full</u> Health First Colorado or CHP+ benefits. (Refer to 8.100.3.G.1.g.viii.a-b for programs eligible for full MA coverage with CAC)</p> 
Services Overview	<p>Health First Colorado and CHP+ provide four kinds of basic benefits (coverage may vary by program):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical health (including prenatal and postpartum care) • Dental • Vision • Behavioral health (mental health and substance use treatment)



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
