

Adult Financial Household Composition and Circumstances

An Adult Financial household consists of individuals who are married or separated, regardless of living arrangement.

Note: An individual who is legally separated shall not have their estranged spouse considered as part of the Adult Financial household.

Each applicant for Adult Financial will have a separate CBMS case and eligibility will be considered on their own case.

CBMS pages to determine Household Composition include (but not limited to):

- Demographic/Marital Status
- Household Relationship
- Attributes
