* Reading the Rights and Responsibilities is only a requirement for SNAP; however, it is best practice to always ensure all clients understand the "What I Should Know" section of the SPA.

^ Interview requirements are waived for SNAP households in which all adults are either elderly or disabled (E/D) and have no earned income at recertification. An interview must still be completed at recertification if the household: could potentially be denied for SNAP, specifically requests an interview, or has any outstanding issues or questions regarding the recertification process.
