

AdviseMENTS for Members that Decide to Opt-Out of a Prenatal Category

Before making any changes in CBMS, a technician **MUST** advise members who decide to opt-out of a prenatal category of the risks involved in opting out:

1

If the member is determined to not be eligible for any other program, they will **NOT** be automatically put back into the prenatal program. Their coverage will be **TERMINATED.**

2

The member also has to report their current income, if determined ineligible, their coverage will be **TERMINATED.**

3

If the member chooses to change programs and are determined eligible, they **MAY NOT** have coverage right away. Timely noticing for the change applies.

Data Entry to Opt-Out of a Prenatal Category

Data Entry:

1. Navigate to the Case Individual Program Requested Page.
2. Click **“YES”** on the Opt-Out radio button for MAGI Pregnant or CHP+ Prenatal.
3. Enter an Effective Begin Date for this record as the date in which the member requested to opt-out of the program.

Workers **MUST NOT** update these buttons, unless the member **SPECIFICALLY REQUESTS** to opt out.

Enrollment Fee

When a Medical Assistance case is in ongoing mode and an individual is found eligible for CHP+, CBMS will charge an enrollment fee if an enrollment fee has not been paid in the previous 12 months.

EXAMPLE: Ongoing case with mom and 2 children receiving Transitional Medical Assistance. The Transitional MA 12 months is ending on 03/2021 (still in Ongoing mode). Eligibility is run and mom is determined not eligible for any aid code but the children are eligible in CHP+ (new CHP+ certification period ending 12/31/2021).

Even though the case is in Ongoing mode, a CHP+ Enrollment Fee will be charged for the children.

CBMS will charge an enrollment fee at **RRR** even when the RRR is started early and the previous enrollment fee was paid less than 12 months ago.

EXAMPLE: Ongoing case with mom and 2 children (04/2020 – 03/2021). Mom is not eligible in any aid code, the children are eligible in CHP+. The previous CHP+ Enrollment fee was received on 04/10/2020. The client returns the RRR packet (or completes PEAK RRR) on 12/05/2020. The RRR is started and processed on 12/06/2020.

In RRR mode, eligibility is running for 02/2021 and 03/2021. Even though the previous enrollment fee was paid less than 12 months ago, the case is in RRR mode, therefore a new fee will be charged.
