

# SNAP Income Verification Logic Modification – Project 14603



## OVERVIEW

With this project, updates were made to CBMS logic to ensure that eligibility is not determined for SNAP cases that have unverified income or unverified income expenses. This logic will be applied at Intake and RRR only.

## PROJECT CHANGES

- Due to federal SNAP updates, all income and income expenses must be verified prior to determining SNAP eligibility.
- Client statement is now an acceptable verification source in CBMS for SNAP for self-employment income and expenses.
  - This means CBMS will no longer generate a VCL for self-employment income or expenses for SNAP when client statement is used as the verification source.
- Income expense must be verified with an acceptable source in CBMS to be counted for SNAP eligibility purposes. If income expense verifications are not received by the VCL due date and there are no other outstanding verifications, SNAP will pass (if all other eligibility conditions are met), but the income expenses will not be counted.
- CBMS will pend for unverified income.
  - This includes even if there are other verified reasons that will make the household ineligible.
