


When is the Consolidated Work Notice Triggered?



Example 1


Clara is approved for SNAP. She is 36 years old and has two kids of 7 and 11 years old. The worker must trigger the Consolidated Work Notice with Basic Work Rules for Clara, because she has no work exemptions and is not an ABAWD.





Example 2

Marcelo is approved for SNAP. He is 49 years old. He reported that his youngest son turned 18. Marcelo is now an ABAWD and does not have a qualifying work exemption. The worker must trigger a Consolidated Work Notice with Basic Work Rules and Time Limit Rules.



ABAWDs are clients between 18-49 years of age, physically and/or mentally able to work, and do not have anyone under the age of 18 as part of their SNAP household.
