

Consolidated Work Notice

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

The Able Bodied Adult Without Dependents (ABAWD) notification will be replaced with the *Consolidated Work Notice*.

See below to get a quick review on how to trigger this notification:



DATA ENTRY

Look for the *CBMS Work Registration Page WBT* in COLearn, under the section with the same name, to learn more about the data entry.



When is the Consolidated Work Notice Triggered?

Example 1

Clara is approved for SNAP. She is 36 years old and has two kids of 7 and 11 years old. The worker must trigger the Consolidated Work Notice with Basic Work Rules for Clara, because she has no work exemptions and is not an ABAWD.

Example 2

Marcelo is approved for SNAP. He is 49 years old. He reported that his youngest son turned 14. Marcelo is now an ABAWD and does not have a qualifying work exemption or an ABAWD Exemption. The worker must trigger a Consolidated Work Notice with Basic Work Rules and Time Limit Rules.

ABAWDS are SNAP recipients who are 18-64 yrs old, physically and mentally able to work and do not have children under the 14 as part of their SNAP household.
